## What is Faith Promise?

Faith Promise is one of the most meaningful ways to support missions. It is not a pledge. Faith Promise is exactly what is says a promise made in faith between an individual and God. That promise is based on what the giver believes God wants him or her to give to ministries beyond those of the local church.

#### Faith Promise is not new.

For decades, hundreds of thousands of Christians have been involved in Faith Promise. Exciting stories abound of persons who have seen God provide their funds for Faith Promise in unexpected and seemingly miraculous ways. Giving through Faith Promise is an adventure and an opportunity to allow God to show how He can provide when we open our hearts and our pocketbooks to do generous things for His Kingdom.

Faith Promise is a God ordained adventure. It is a Covenant made between God and ourselves based on our faith in God's ability to supply out of His resources what we cannot give out of our own. Faith Promise involves me listening to God, promising to give as He impresses upon me, and trusting Him to provide.

### How is my Faith Promise used?

Faith Promise provides for outreach in155 world areas, support for almost 800 Missionaries around the world, training for almost 6000 national workers, Jesus Film Evangelism, schools, Bible colleges, & seminaries, medical clinics & hospitals, literature in over 80 languages, child sponsorships and disaster relief efforts. 14,000 churches + 4000 missions around the world, Work & Witness teams to do evangelism & construction.

## How do I make a Faith Promise Commitment?

Each family decides what they will give, above their tithe and offerings, on a regular basis for these mission efforts. On April 15 each family is given a card to fill out showing what they have committed, through faith, to give this next church year. The total of those funds gives our Mission Council an idea of how many of our ministries we will be able to support this year. Our goal is 100% of them!

SCOTT AND EMILY ARE GLOBAL MISSIONARIES WITH THE CHURCH OF THE NAZARENE AND HAVE BEEN MINISTERING IN THE MESOAMERICA REGIONAL OFFICE SINCE JANUARY 2004. SCOTT AND EMILY ARE CO-COORDINATING MESOAMERICA GLOBAL MISSION & MESOAMERICA GENESIS. GLOBAL MISSION SEEKS TO DISCOVER, DEVELOP & DEPLOY MISSIONARIES FROM THE COUNTRIES OF MEXICO, CENTRAL AMERICA AND THE CARIBBEAN. GENESIS IS A REGIONAL INITIATIVE TO MAKE CHRIST-LIKE DISCIPLES IN THE URBAN CENTERS OF MESOAMERICA; TEAMS OF 3-6 VOLUNTEER MISSIONARIES ARE SENT TO 28 STRATEGIC SITES IN ORDER TO DEVELOP NEW CHURCHES AND ORGANIZE CONGREGATIONS IN THE HEART OF THE CITIES.

SINCE 2004, THE ARMSTRONGS HAVE SERVED UNDER THE STRUCTURE OF THE MESOAMERICA REGIONAL OFFICE AND HAVE LIVED IN GUATEMALA, COSTA RICA AND PANAMA. THEY HAVE COORDINATED MINISTRIES OF NYI AND REGIONAL MISSIONARY PERSONNEL, IN ADDITION TO GLOBAL MISSION. CURRENTLY THEY ARE LIVING IN SANTO DOMINGO, DOMINICAN REPUBLIC.

BOTH SCOTT AND EMILY GRADUATED FROM OLIVET NAZARENE UNIVERSITY IN 1999. EMILY RECEIVED HER BACHELOR OF SCIENCE DEGREE IN NURSING AND SCOTT RECEIVED HIS BACHELOR OF ARTS DEGREE IN SPEECH COMMUNICATION. THEY ALSO HAVE BOTH GRADUATED FROM NAZARENE THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY WITH THEIR MASTERS OF DIVINITY -SCOTT IN 2003 AND EMILY IN 2016.

SCOTT AND EMILY HAVE A SPECIAL INTEREST IN WORKING WITH CHILDREN AND YOUTH AS THEY DISCERN THE WILL OF GOD IN THEIR LIVES AND HOW MISSIONS MIGHT BE A PART OF THEIR CALL. SCOTT ACCEPTED HIS CALL TO MISSIONS AS A STUDENT AT OLIVET, AND EMILY ANSWERED GOD'S CALL TO MISSIONS AS A CHILD.
